

SECTION VI - REACTIVITY DATA

STABILITY.....NORMALLY STABLE
INCOMPATIBLE MATERIALS.....STRONG ACIDS. CONTACT WITH CERTAIN MATERIALS MAY YIELD EXPLOSIVE HYDROGEN GAS.
DECOMPOSITION PRODUCTS....DISPOSES OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE, LOCAL AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

SECTION VII - SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURE

PROCEDURES.....WEAR PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (SEE SECTION VIII). NEUTRALIZE USING A WEAK ACID. CLEAN UP WITH ABSORBENT MATERIALS.
WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD.....DISPOSE OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

SECTION VIII - SPECIAL PROTECTION

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION: NOT NORMALLY REQUIRED. IF TLV IS EXCEEDED OR FOR SYMPTOMS OF OVEREXPOSURE WEAR NIOSH APPROVED DUST/MIST RESPIRATOR.
EYEWEAR: IF SPLASH POTENTIAL EXISTS, WEAR CHEMICAL GOGGLES OR FACESHIELD..
VENTILATION: LOCAL EXHAUST MAY BE NECESSARY UNDER SOME HANDLING/USE CONDITIONS. SPECIFIC NEEDS SHOULD BE ADDRESSED BY SUPERVISORY OR HEALTH/SAFETY PERSONNEL.
CLOTHING/PROTECTIVE GLOVES: WEAR NEOPRENE OR OTHER CHEMICAL RESISTANT GLOVES AS NEEDED TO PREVENT PROLONGED SKIN CONTACT.
