



SECTION V – HEALTH HAZARD DATA

OVEREXPOSURE EFFECTS.....INHALATION OF MIST MAY CAUSE RESPIRATORY PROBLEMS. PROLONGED CONTACT MAY CAUSE SKIN IRRITATION AND DERMATITIS. EYE CONTACT IS IRRITATING

FIRST AID PROCEDURES:

EYES: IMMEDIATELY FLUSH EYES WITH LARGE AMOUNTS OF WATER WHILE HOLDING THE EYELIDS OPEN. GET PROMPT MEDICAL ATTENTION.

SKIN: WASH AFFECTED AREA WITH WATER. IF IRRITATION PERSISTS GET MEDICAL ADVICE.

INHALATION: NOT CONSIDERED A HAZARDOUS ROUTE OF EXPOSURE.

INGESTION: CONTACT LOCAL POISON CENTER OR PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY!!

SECTION VI - REACTIVITY DATA

STABILITY: STABLE

INCOMPATIBLE MATERIALS: STRONG OXIDIZERS.

DECOMPOSITION PRODUCTS: CARBON OXIDES.

SECTION VII - SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURE

PROCEDURES: CAREFULLY CLEAN UP SPILLED MATERIAL WITH ABSORBENT MATERIAL.

WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD: DISPOSE OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION: NOT NORMALLY REQUIRED. IF TLV IS EXCEEDED OR FOR SYMPTOMS OF OVER EXPOSURE, WEAR NIOSH APPROVED DUST/MIST RESPIRATOR.

EYEWEAR: IF POTENTIAL FOR EYE CONTACT EXISTS, WEAR CHEMICAL GOGGLES.

VENTILATION: LOCAL EXHAUST MAY BE NECESSARY UNDER SOME HANDLING/USE CONDITIONS. SPECIFIC NEEDS SHOULD BE ADDRESSED BY SUPERVISORY OR HEALTH/SAFETY PERSONNEL

CLOTHING/PROTECTIVE GLOVES: GENERALLY NOT REQUIRED.
